



EMPOWERS FREE JOB TRAINING



ESDEC EMPOWERS

Our very first project was simply called Esdec Empowers, which we did in a partner-ship with Gemeente Deventer, Konnected, Aventus, BDA, and Esdec. The project was focused on supporting the unemployed. Empowers provided the training needed to become professional, certified solar installers, and with the partners that helped the installers find jobs.

When Bram learned about the free Empowers Solar Training, he immediately thought about the chance for a new career. "There are a lot of solar panels that must be installed. I don't have a technical background, but I am handy, so I decided to go for it."

After a training of 10 days, Bram is now a fully certified installer and knows his way around panels and inverters on the roof. "At Esdec's Innovation Center, we have trained on life size pitched roofs. That was useful." Now Bram has a job at Cottus (an installation company in Apeldoorn, the Netherlands). "I enjoy being a solar installer, and I learn every day. This way I can build on a sustainable future, also for the people around me. My life is back on track, I take pride in the work I do, and I am very happy to be given the opportunity to do the training."



EMPOWERS SOLAR PROJECTS





Stichting Open Door supports and guides young disabled people, helping them to become self-supportive. Empowers' goal is to usher in a greener world for future generations. By donating a FlatFix Fusion system to the new OpenDorp home of Stichting Open Door, we support a green and equal community for the people who reside there.

OpenDorp is a new home started by the OpenDoor foundation in Loon op Zand the Netherlands and is housing 8 young adults with disabilities.

In April of 2022 the extensive reconstruction project was completed. As a result the building is gas free and mainly run by solar and geothermal energy.

Empowers supported the delivery of the mounting structure, while Trina delivered the modules, and SolarEdge donated the Inverter. The installation of the solar system was done by many volunteers with the guidance of a professional solar installer.

of 30 modules went very smooth and with the help of 2 Esdec volunteers, it was completed within 5 hours.

This system will generate over 10,000 kWh / year, which corresponds with annual savings of €7,000. In addition to savings, we have realized a zeroemission house."


US based Wolfpack Robotics is part of the nationwide FIRST Inspires Program founded by Dean Kamen over 30 years ago. Wolfpack Robotics uses known strategies to increase students' interest in STEM education, a teaching approach that combines science, technology, engineering, and math.

Wolfpack Robotics' mission is to inspire young people to be science and technology leaders and innovators by engaging them in exciting mentor-based programs that build STEM skills. This aligns with Empowers' mission perfectly, as it supports not only STEM education but also teamwork, communication, and leadership.

Empowers has become one of the key sponsors of Wolfpack, providing financial support, allowing Wolfpack to source all the parts and components needed for the robot the build each season.



NATIVE RENEWABLES

"Native Renewables is a Native American, female-led non-profit with the mission of empowering Native Nations through Solar. With a focus on the Navajo & Hopi Nations, NRI offers community-based solar education, a workforce development program aimed at Native American solar installers & has a goal to provide access to off-grid solar PV systems for 15,000 reservation-based homes that do not have access to the utility grid.

In 2022, Empowers kicked-off support of these initiatives with a donation of \$10,000, partnered the IronRidge Installer Certification Program with Native Renewables. Enabling them to certify all future participants in their workforce development program as Certified IronRidge Installers. They also developed an internal STEM contest that invited the entire Esdec community to help create an educational STEM-focused game that will be distributed to the families that Native Renewables serves.

Moving forward, I'm thrilled to continue working with Empowers & Native Renewables to expand our collective impact through continued partnership, as well as through development of the Empowers Solar Education Program, which will help bridging the gap between historically excluded communities and access to sustainable, solar powered energy."

1,500 KIDS RECEIVE SOLAR FOCUSED EDUCATION




